Consumer Affairs (Resale of Tickets) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 provides the commencement provision.

Clause 3 provides that the Consumer Affairs Act 1972 is the Principal Act.

Clause 4 provides for the insertion of sections 21, 22, 23, 24 into Part II, Division 4 of the Consumer Affairs Act 1972.

Section 21 provides for the definitions of various terms.

Section 22 provides for the Minister to proclaim an event and to prescribe the resale price of tickets to such events.

Section 23 sets out restrictions on the resale of tickets to a proclaimed event and provides penalties for their contravention.

Section 24 provides that the Governor in Council may make regulations regarding the advertising for the resale of tickets for proclaimed events.

Clause 5 provides for the repeal or amendment of sections of the Consumer Affairs Act 1972.
