Cattle and Swine Compensation (Amendment) Bill **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 provides for the Bill to come into operation on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Clause 3 amends the Cattle Compensation Act 1967 to allow payment to the credit of the Cattle Compensation Fund of all interest earned on money in the fund, and to allow certain payments towards any research that might be of benefit to the cattle industry.

Clause 4 amends the Swine Compensation Act 1967 to allow payment to the credit of the Swine Compensation Fund of all interest earned on money in the Fund, thereby allowing interest earned to be used for projects of benefit to the swine industry.
