

Construction Industry (Electrical and Metal Trades) Long Service Leave Bill 1982

NOTES ON CLAUSES

The purpose of this Bill is to allow the Building Industry Long Service Leave Board to prepare for the extension of the long service leave scheme which is proposed for next year and which will be the subject of legislation during 1983.

Clause 1 contains the usual citation and commencement provisions.

Clause 2 directs the Building Industry Long Service Leave Board to do all acts and things that may be necessary in contemplation of the extension of the operation of the portable long service leave scheme to include electrical and metal trades construction workers.

Sub-clause (2) permits money to be paid out of the Building Industry Long Service Leave Fund for the purpose of this Bill.

Sub-clause (3) provides for the repayment of the money paid out of the Fund. The money will be repaid from contributions from electrical and metal trades construction employers when the scheme is extended.

Sub-clause (4) provides the method for the fixing of the rate of interest to be charged on money paid out of the Fund.

Clause 3 provides for the Treasurer to guarantee the repayment to the Building Industry Long Service Leave Board of money paid out of the Building Industry Long Service Leave Fund for the purposes of this Bill.
