EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

- Clause 1 sets out the purposes of the Act.
- Clause 2 provides for the Act to come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- Clause 3 sets out the definitions of terms used in the Act.

PART 2—JUDICIAL STUDIES BOARD

- Clause 4 establishes the Judicial Studies Board.
- Clause 5 sets out the functions of the Judicial Studies Board.
- Clause 6 sets out the power of the Board to request information.
- Clause 7 lists the composition of the membership of the Judicial Studies Board.
- Clause 8 sets out the terms and conditions for board members.
- Clause 9 provides for the appointment of a Director.
- Clause 10 provides for the appointment of staff to the Board.
- Clause 11 defines the procedure for meetings of the Board.
- Clause 12 confers validity for acts and decisions of the Board.
- Clause 13 sets out the requirement of the Board to keep proper accounts and records.
- Clause 14 provides for the preparation of an annual report each financial year and describes what it is to include.
 - Clause 15 provides for an audit of all the financial statements of the Board.
 - Clause 16 states that the financial year of the Board is to commence on 1 July.

PART 3—BUREAU OF CRIME STATISTICS AND RESEARCH

- Clause 17 establishes a Bureau of Crime Research and Statistics.
- Clause 18 prescribes the functions of the Bureau.
- Clause 19 empowers the Bureau to request any body, governmental or non-governmental to supply it with any information needed by the Bureau to enable it to perform its functions.
 - Clause 20 appoints the Director of the Bureau and describes the office of the Director.
 - Clause 21 provides for the appointment of staff to the Bureau.
- Clause 22 provides for a committee to advise the Bureau on research priorities and sets out the composition of that committee.

Clause 23 sets out the requirement of the Bureau to keep proper accounts and records.

Clause 24 provides for the preparation of an annual report each financial year and describes what it is to include.

Clause 25 provides for an audit of all the financial statements of the Bureau.

Clause 26 states that the financial year of the Bureau starts on 1 July.
