Egg Industry (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 specifies the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 specifies that the Act is to come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Clause 3 inserts into the Egg Industry Act 1989 a new provision which will allow a person to apply to the Egg Industry Licensing Committee for a permit to own and keep, in addition to quota, hens for egg production for human consumption to meet domestic demand for egg products.
