Interpretation of Legislation (Amendment) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 recites the Short Title of the Bill.

Clause 2 provides for commencement upon Royal Assent.

Clause 3 cites the Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984 as the Principal Act.

Clause 4 amends section 32 of the Principal Act to enable matters to be prescribed in subordinate instruments by reference to a Code, as well as an Act or a statutory rule. Code is defined in sub-clause (c).
