

Liquor Control (Booth Licences) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 cites the short title.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement on Royal Assent.

Clause 3 cites the *Liquor Control Act 1968* as the Principal Act.

Clause 4 amends section 27 of the Principal Act—

Paragraph (a) amends sub-section (1) of section (1) of section 27 to remove the present restriction on the sale and disposal of liquor pursuant to a booth licence on a Sunday.

Paragraph (b) substitutes sub-section (1AA) of section 27. The new sub-section (1AA) provides that liquor may be sold and disposed of pursuant to a booth licence after eleven o'clock in the morning on a Sunday. The present sub-section (1AA) makes the same provision but only in respect of booths at the MCG during the holding of cricket matches.
