

## Land (Revocation of Reservations) Bill

### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 sets out the purposes of the Bill.
- Clause 2 sets out the commencement dates of the various provisions of the Act.
- Clause 3 provides for—
- (i) the revocation of a portion of land set aside as a Site for recreation purposes; and
  - (ii) the revocation of a portion of land set aside as a Site for public purposes—
- at Bairnsdale, to allow for their re-reservation for education purposes as the current reservations are no longer appropriate for the purposes for which the land is used.
- Clause 4 provides for the revocation of a reservation over land set aside as a Site for Watering and Camping purposes at Korkuperrimul (near Bacchus Marsh), to facilitate disposal of the land.
- Clause 5 provides for the revocation of a reservation over land set aside as a Site for a Shire Hall at Nunawading in order to facilitate disposal of the land.
- Clause 6 provides that, on revocation of a reservation of land the land is deemed to be unalienated land of the Crown, freed from any encumbrances and the appointment of any committee of management and any regulations are revoked to the extent that they apply to the land.
- Clause 7 requires the Registrar-General and Registrar of Titles to make any amendments to records that are necessary because of the operation of this Act.
