

Monash University (Pharmacy College) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 provides for the Act to come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Clause 3 provides definitions and establishes the appointed day as the day on which Victorian College of Pharmacy (Monash University) Limited is dissolved.

PART 2—MERGER

Clause 4 provides that Monash is the successor in law of the College.

Clause 5 provides for the transfer of gifts, trusts, etc. from the College to Monash.

Clause 6 provides for members of staff of the College to become members of staff of Monash.

Clause 7 provides for students of the College to become students of Monash, for the conferring of awards, and for the transfer of benefits and privileges of holders of awards.

Clause 8 provides for indemnity of former members of Council of the College.

Clause 9 provides for the transfer to Monash of certain land used by the College.

Clause 10 provides for amendments of the Register under the **Transfer of Land Act 1958**.

Clause 11 provides for the continuation of regulations of the College as regulations of Monash.

Clause 12 provides that the College and its Council shall be deemed to have had the power to take action as required for the purposes of the merger with Monash in accordance with this Act.

Clause 13 amends Schedule 2 to the **Post-Secondary Education Act 1978** to omit “Victorian College of Pharmacy Limited”.

Clause 14 provides for amendment of the **Monash University Act 1958** to establish a college of the university called “Victorian College of Pharmacy”.
