EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 outlines the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 is the commencement provision.

Clause 3 repeals section 14 of the **Probate Duty Act 1962**. This removes the requirement that, before dealings concerning the assets of a deceased person can be effected, the Commissioner of State Revenue must certify that the appropriate duty has been paid or that he consents to that dealing.
