

Post-Secondary Education Remuneration Tribunal (Repeal) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 sets out the purposes of the Act.

Clause 2 provides for the Act to come into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

Clause 3 provides—

- (1) for the repeal of the *Post-Secondary Education Remuneration Tribunal Act 1980*;
- (2) for the abolition of the Post-Secondary Education Remuneration Tribunal;
- (3) that determinations of the Tribunal shall be enforceable by the Industrial Relations Commission until such time as Conciliation and Arbitration Boards are established;
- (4) that matters part heard by the Tribunal at the date of proclamation of the Act shall be concluded by the Tribunal.

Clause 4 provides for the insertion of a new section 55B in the *Industrial Relations Act 1979* to enable the Council of Academic Staff Associations, subject to the decision of the Commission, to be recognized as an association of employees for the purposes of section 53 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1979*.

Clause 5 provides for the amendment of the *Council of Adult Education Act 1981* to enable the Commission to exercise jurisdiction over Council employees.
