Racing (Fixed Percentage Distribution) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 contains the provision relating to the short title.

Clause 2 provides that the commencement of the Act shall be on a day proclaimed by the Governor in Council and published in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3 provides that the Racing Act 1958 is the Principal Act.

Clause 4 (a) amends section 1161 (1A) by substituting a scheme of fixed percentage distribution of the surplus of the Totalizator Agency Board whereby in any year—

horse racing clubs receive 73.25 per centum;

harness racing clubs receive 18.00 per centum;

greyhound racing clubs receive 8.75 per centum.

(b) repeals paragraph (d) of sub-section (1B) as this is no longer relevant.

Clause 5 (1) repeals section 16 of the Racing (Amendment) Act 1983 which had inserted a "sunset clause" provision in respect of the matters contained in that Act.

Clause 5 (2) repeals the Racing (Amendment) Act 1984 which had extended the original sunset date of 1 April 1985 in the Racing (Amendment) Act 1983 to a date of 1 April 1987.

The provisions of the *Racing (Amendment)*. Act 1983 will therefore not be subject to any sunset date.
