Road Safety (Photographic Detection Devices) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 sets out the purposes of the Act.

Clause 2 provides for the Act to come into operation on Royal Assent.

Clause 3 refers to the Road Safety Act 1986 as the Principal Act.

Clause 4 repeals sections 66 (6), 67 (8), 80 (2) and 81 (2) of the Principal Act each of which declares that the particular section expires on 31 December 1988. The clause will therefore prevent the expiry of the Principal Act provisions which relate to the following matters:

Section 66: Offences detected by a photographic detection device.

Section 67: Procedure for offences under section 66.

Section 80: Certain matters indicated by camera devices are sufficient evidence.

Section 81: Certain matters indicated by speed camera devices are sufficient evidence.
