University Acts (Further Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

Clause 1 provides that the purpose of this Act is to amend Acts establishing Victorian universities and the Victorian College of the Arts Act 1981.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the Bill.

PART 2—AMENDMENT OF MONASH UNIVERSITY ACT 1958

Clause 3 amends the objects of the University to widen the range of organisations which may be affiliated with the University.

Clause 4 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for council meetings.

Clause 5 specifies that the Council may as prescribed revoke any degree or diploma conferred or awarded by the University.

Clause 6 makes provision for the College Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for College Board meetings.

Clause 7 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Academic Board meetings.

Clause 8 amends the power of affiliation to widen the range of organisations which may be affiliated with the University.

Clause 9 makes provision for the University to borrow or obtain financial accommodation within the meaning of the **Borrowing and Investment Powers Act** 1987.

Clause 10 inserts a heading for division 7 (a) of the Act which provides for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc.

Clause 11 amends provisions for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc. and provides for the University to notify the Minister when such action is taken.

Clause 12 repeals section 41 of the Monash University Act 1958 to remove a requirement to provide a copy of annual reports to the Governor in Council.

PART 3—AMENDMENT OF MELBOURNE UNIVERSITY ACT 1958

Clause 13 makes consequential amendments to provisions relating to the composition of the Council of the University.

Clause 14 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 15 amends the power for affiliation of other organisations to include educational institutions, organisations or bodies.

Clause 16 makes provision for the Committee of Convocation to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Committee meetings.

Clause 17 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 18 provides for regulations made by the Vice-Chancellor to take effect from the day on which they are promulgated.

Clause 19 repeals section 46 of the **Melbourne University Act 1958** to remove a requirement to provide a copy of annual reports to the Governor in Council.

PART 4—AMENDMENT OF LA TROBE UNIVERSITY ACT 1964

Clause 20 amends the La Trobe University Act 1964 to make provision for prescription of certain matters by regulation under statutes.

Clause 21 provides for the terms of office of Council members to be completed on 31 December in the relevant year.

Clause 22 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 23 makes provision for the appointment of a person to act as Vice-Chancellor.

Clause 24 specifies that the Council may as prescribed revoke any degree or diploma conferred or awarded by the University.

Clause 25 makes provision for the indemnification of members of Council and members of committees constituted or appointed by the Council.

Clause 26 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 27 amends provisions for the making of statutes and regulations with respect to academic awards and affiliation of other organisations.

Clause 28 makes provision for the University to borrow or obtain financial accommodation within the meaning of the Borrowing and Investment Powers Act 1987.

Clause 29 inserts a heading for a new **Division 9** which deals with the formation and membership of companies joint ventures etc.

Clause 30 amends provisions for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc. and provides for the University to notify the Minister when such action is taken.

Clause 31 repeals section 41 of the La Trobe University Act 1964 to remove a requirement to provide a copy of annual reports to the Governor in Council.

Clause 32 makes transitional provisions for Council members consequential on the change in date for completion of terms of office.

PART 5—AMENDMENT OF DEAKIN UNIVERSITY ACT 1974

Clause 33 amends the size of the Council by the addition of two persons appointed by the Governor in Council and removes a limitation on the number of terms which a member may serve.

Clause 34 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 35 specifies that the Council may as prescribed revoke any degree, diploma or certificate conferred or awarded by the University.

Clause 36 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 37 amends the power of affiliation to widen the range of organisations which may be affiliated with the University.

Clause 38 makes provision for the University to borrow or obtain financial accommodation within the meaning of the Borrowing and Investment Powers Act 1987.

Clause 39 amends a clause regulating investment of trust funds.

Clause 40 inserts a heading for **Division 7** of the Act which provides for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc.

Clause 41 amends provisions for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc. and provides for the University to notify the Minister when such action is taken.

Clause 42 repeals section 37 of the **Deakin University Act 1974** to remove a requirement to provide a copy of annual reports to the Governor in Council.

Clause 43 makes statute law revisions to the Deakin University Act 1974.

PART 6—AMENDMENT OF VICTORIAN COLLEGE OF THE ARTS ACT 1981

Clause 44 amends the objects of the Victorian College of the Arts with respect to offering courses and conferring certificates and other awards.

Clause 45 removes an age restriction for members of the Council and a limitation on the number of terms which a member may serve.

Clause 46 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 47 makes provision for the Board of Studies to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 48 amends the power to make statutes with respect to the granting of degrees and conferral of diplomas, certificates or other awards.

Clause 49 amends a clause regulating investment of trust funds.

Clause 50 makes a statute law revision in the Victorian College of the Arts Act 1981.

PART 7—AMENDMENT OF VICTORIA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY ACT 1990

- Clause 51 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.
- Clause 52 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings,
- Clause 53 makes provision for the Board of Technical and Further Education to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.
- Clause 54 amends the power of affiliation to widen the range of organisations which can be affiliated with the University.
 - Clause 55 amends a clause regulating investment of trust funds.
- Clause 56 amends provision for the University to borrow or obtain financial accommodation within the meaning of the **Borrowing and Investment Powers Act 1987**.
- Clause 57 makes a statute law revision in the University Acts (Amendment) Act 1994.

PART 8—AMENDMENT OF SWINBURNE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY ACT 1992

Clause 58 alters the term used for non academic staff of the University, removes limitations on the number of terms which can be served by a member of Council and provides for completion of terms of office of Council members on 31 December in the relevant year.

Clause 59 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 60 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 61 makes provision for the Board of Technical and Further Education to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 62 removes a requirement for approval of the Minister for the making of statutes for the purposes of the Technical and Further Education Division of the Act.

Clause 63 amends the power of affiliation to widen the range of organisations which may be affiliated with the University.

Clause 64 makes provision for the University to borrow or obtain financial accommodation within the meaning of the Borrowing and Investment Powers Act 1987.

Clause 65 provides for a requirement of approval by the Minister before alienation of land granted to the University.

Clause 66 amends a clause regulating investment of trust funds.

Clause 67 amends provisions for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc. and provides for the University to notify the Minister when such action is taken.

Clause 68 makes a transitional arrangement for members of the Council consequential on the change in date for completion of terms of office.

PART 9—AMENDMENT OF ROYAL MELBOURNE INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY ACT 1992

Clause 69 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 70 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 71 makes provision for the Board of Technical Studies to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 72 amends the power of affiliation to widen the range of organisations which may be affiliated with the University.

Clause 73 amends a clause regulating investment of trust funds.

Clause 74 amends provisions for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc. and provides for the University to notify the Minister when such action is taken.

Clause 75 makes a statute law revision in the University Acts (Amendment) Act 1994.

PART 10—AMENDMENT OF UNIVERSITY OF BALLARAT ACT 1993

Clause 76 makes provision for the Council to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Council meetings.

Clause 77 makes provision for the Academic Board to make resolutions without meetings and provides for approved methods of communication for Board meetings.

Clause 78 amends the power of affiliation to widen the range of organisations which may be affiliated with the University.

Clause 79 makes provision for the University of borrow or obtain financial accommodation within the meaning of the Borrowing and Investment Powers Act 1987.

Clause 80 amends provisions for the formation and membership of companies, joint ventures etc. and provides for the University to notify the Minister when such action is taken.
