Victorian Arts Centre (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 states the purpose of the Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the Act.

Clause 3 defines the "Principal Act" as the Victorian Arts Centre Act 1979.

Clause 4 amends the functions of the Trust in section 5 of the Principal Act to enable the Trust to carry on a business of providing ticketing, inventory management of admissions, marketing and related services.

Clause 5 amends the powers of the Trust in section 6 of the Principal Act to enable the Trust, with the consent in writing of the Minister after consultation with the Treasurer, to be a member of, to form or participate in the formation of, or to enter into a joint venture in the performance of its functions.

Clause 6 repeals spent provisions in the Principal Act.
