## Victoria Conservation Trust (Amendment) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 explains the purpose of the Bill.
- Clause 2 states the Bill will come into operation on receiving Royal Assent.
- Clause 3 identifies the Principal Act as the Victoria Conservation Act 1972.
- Clause 4 amends the title of the Trust to the Victorian Conservation Trust.
- Clause 5 amends the term member(s) to trustee(s).
- Clause 6 inserts provision in section 3A (10) (c) in the Principal Act to allow for positive covenants.
- Clause 7 amends section 4 of the Principal Act to increase membership from five to nine.
- Clause 8 amends section 7 (2) of the Principal Act to increase the quorum from three to five.
- Clause 9 inserts a number of provisions relating to the annual reporting of the operations and accounts of the Victorian Conservation Trust.
  - Clause 10 inserts a savings provision.
