EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Outline

The purpose of this Bill is to make a number of amendments to the Victorian Economic Development Corporation Act 1981 in relation to a number of different matters.

Notes on Clauses

Clause 1 cites the short title as the Victorian Economic Development Corporation (Amendment) Act 1985.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the Act on a day or respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council.

Clause 3 provides that the Victorian Economic Development Corporation Act 1981 is the Principal Act.

Clause 4 (1) amends Section 3 of the Principal Act by substituting a new definition of preferred industry.

(2) repeals a number of sections in the 1982 (Amendment) Act dealing with preferred industry and amends section 6(a) of that Act.

Clause 5 amends Section 12 (2) of the Principal Act by providing the Corporation with a new power to deal in bills of exchange and other negotiable instruments.

Clause 6 amends Section 12 (2) of the Principal Act by empowering the Corporation to give indemnities.
