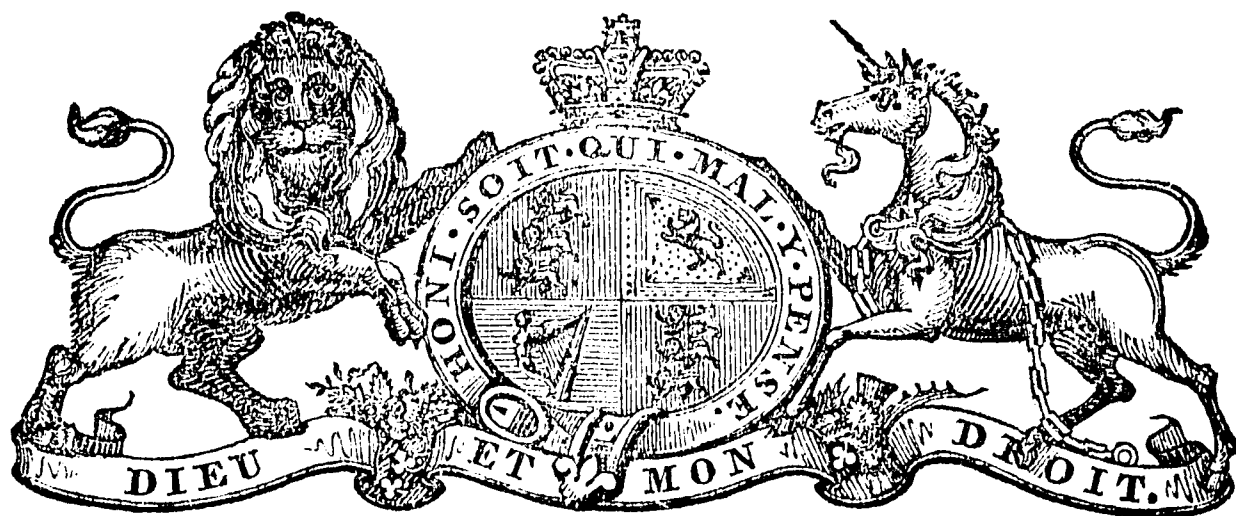

An Act to amend an Act intituled "*An Act for granting Duties of Customs upon Gold exported from Victoria.*" [14th May, 1862.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act of the Lieutenant Governor and Legislative Council of Victoria passed in the eighteenth year of the reign of Her present Majesty intituled "*An Act for granting Duties of Customs upon Gold exported from Victoria*" Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Victoria in the present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

I. On and after the first day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two instead of the duties of customs payable in accordance with the above recited Act upon the exportation of gold from Victoria there shall be payable the duty following that is to say—two shillings per ounce.

II. On and after the first day of January One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three instead of the duty payable as hereinbefore provided upon the exportation of gold from Victoria there shall be payable the duty following that is to say—one shilling and six pence per ounce.
