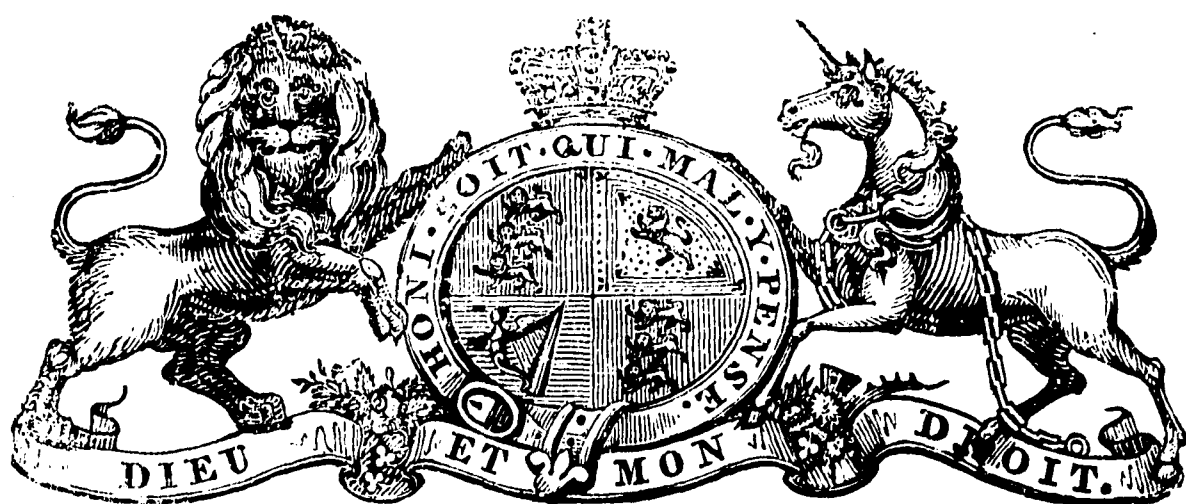

An Act to amend an Act intituled "*An Act to amend
"an Act intituled 'An Act to enable certain
"Public Hospitals to sue and be sued in the name

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the eleventh year of the reign of 11 Vict. 59.
Her present Majesty intituled "*An Act to enable certain Public
Hospitals to sue and be sued in the name of their Treasurer and to
provide for the taking and holding of real property belonging to such
hospitals respectively*" And whereas an Act was passed in the thir- 13 Vict. 20.
teenth year of the reign of Her present Majesty intituled "*An Act to
amend an Act intituled 'An Act to enable certain Public Hospitals to
sue and be sued in the name of their Treasurer and to provide for the
taking and holding of real property belonging to such hospitals
respectively'*" And whereas it is expedient to amend such Acts Be it
enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice
and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of
Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of
the same as follows :

I. That so much of the secondly recited Act as enables a contri-
butor to any hospital to give his or her vote at any public meeting of
the contributors to such hospital by proxy shall be and the same is hereby
repealed Provided always that no person whose name is inscribed in
the list of life governors or life subscribers to any public hospital to
which the provisions of the said recited Acts shall be extended shall be
deprived of his or her right to vote by proxy.

II. No person shall hereafter be qualified to vote at any meeting
of subscribers to any hospital unless he shall have been a subscriber
to such hospital for the space of six months previous to such meeting
Provided always that where a subscriber shall have paid his subscription
for the year immediately preceding the year in which any public
meeting shall take place the payment of his subscription for the then
current year at any time before such meeting shall entitle such subscriber
to vote.
