An Act to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this and the last preceding Session of Parliament.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN—

WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Preamble.
Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament assembled towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this and the last preceding Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted : And be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty a sum not exceeding Seventy-nine million three hundred and sixty-eight thousand seven hundred and ninety-three pounds for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
