An Act to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this and the last preceding Session of Parliament.

Most Gracious Sovereign-

TYPE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Preamble. Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament making good the supply which assembled towards we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this and the last preceding Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and Application of moneys. may be issued and applied for or towards making good the £6,018,478. supply granted to His Majesty a sum not exceeding Six million eighteen thousand four hundred and seventy-eight pounds for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.

2. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts Appropriation of supplies. mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the said First Schedule. Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Thirteen million £13,413,410. four hundred and thirteen thousand four hundred and ten pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 3050 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second FIRST Second Schedule hereto.
