

No. DCCCXX.

An Act to amend "An Act to protect Game." [12th December 1884.]

PE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act shall be construed as one with the Act No. 311.

2. No person shall at any time kill or attempt to kill or destroy Punt guns, &c., not any game or native game with any device or instrument known as a swivel or punt gun or with any gun other than such guns as are habitually raised at arm's length and fired from the shoulder; and any person offending against the provisions of this section shall be liable to Penalty. a penalty not exceeding Twenty pounds.
