

An Act to amend "The Mallee Pastoral Leases Act 1883."

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. The words "of not less than Ten pounds per annum" in the Repeal of words in Fifth Schedule to "*The Mallee Pastoral Leases Act* 1883" are hereby repealed and shall be deemed to have been repealed from the date of the passing of the said Act.
