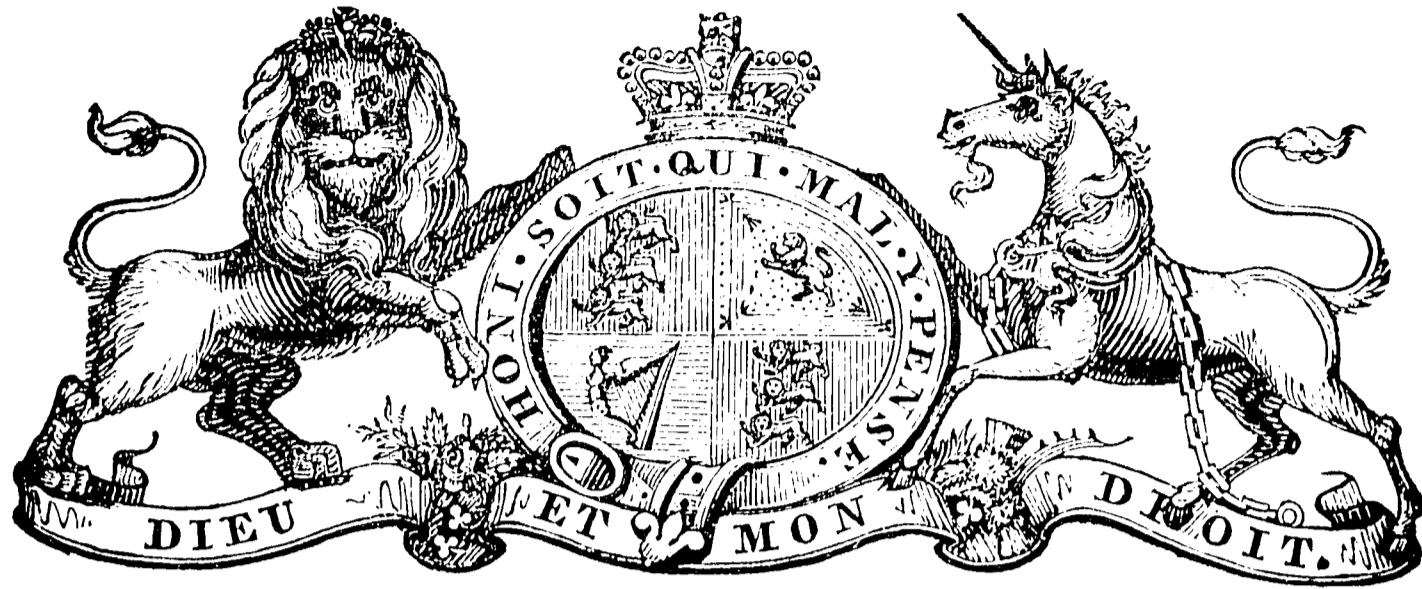

No. DCCCXXX.

An Act to apply out of "*The Victorian Railway Loan and Debentures Redemption Account 1883*" certain sums of money for Preliminary Surveys of Railways and Tramways.

[12th December 1884.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. There may be issued and applied out of "*The Victorian Railway Loan and Debentures Redemption Account 1883*," item 1 of First Schedule Act DCCLX., any sum or sums of money not exceeding Seven thousand pounds for the preliminary surveys of railways and tramways.

Application of moneys for preliminary surveys. No. 760.

2. No other authority than this Act is necessary to authorize the expenditure herein provided.
