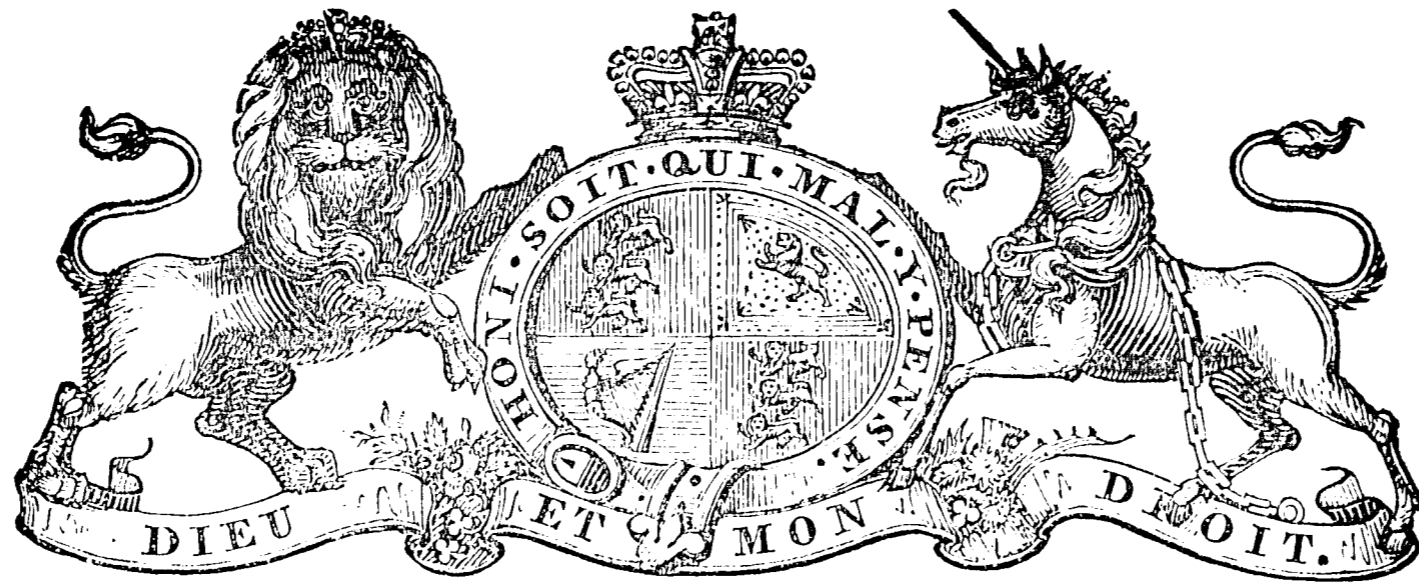

No. DCCCXXIV.

An Act to amend "*The Pounds Act 1874.*"

[12th *December* 1884.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The twelfth section of "*The Pounds Act 1874*" shall be repealed, and there shall be substituted in the said Act for such section the words following, that is to say—

Section 12 of No. 478 repealed.

"In respect of the trespass of any entire horse any bull or any ram there shall be payable as a trespass rate in addition to any other sum fixed under the provisions of this Act by way of trespass rate a sum not exceeding Five pounds."

Trespass rates increased for entire horse bull or ram.
