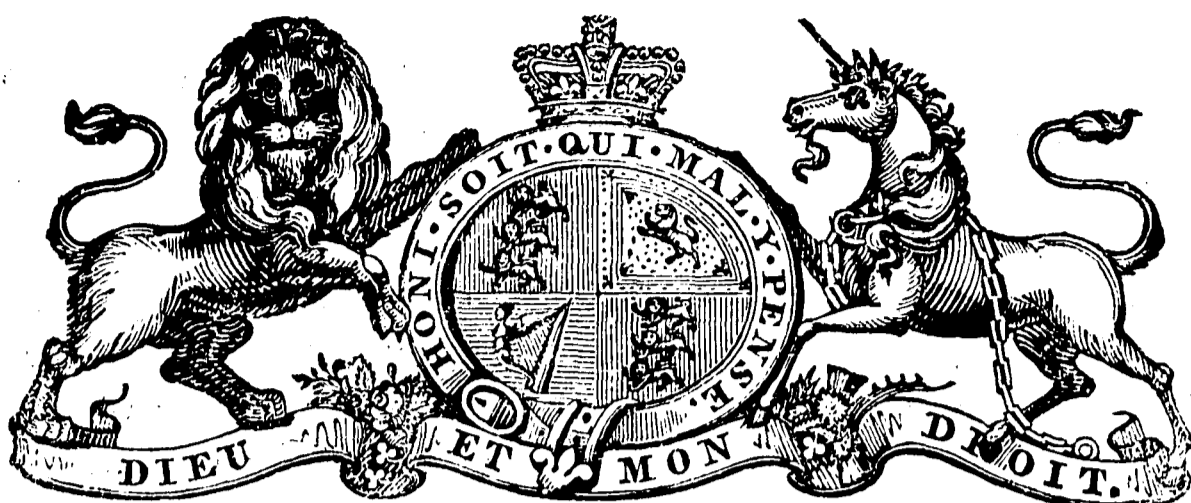

An Act to amend the Law relating to Registration.  
[8th June, 1860.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to make certain provisions as herein- **Preamble.**  
after mentioned for the registration of persons entitled to  
vote in the election of members to serve in the parliament of Victoria  
Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative  
Assembly of Victoria in this present parliament assembled and by the  
authority of the same as follows that is to say—

I. None of the acts matters or things by the Act passed in the  
twenty-second year of Her Majesty's reign numbered LXXXI  
authorised or required to be had or done by or with regard to  
collectors of electoral lists or with regard to the collection of names  
for such lists shall in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty  
be had done or proceeded with but in lieu thereof such proceedings  
shall be taken as hereinafter mentioned. **Collections of names  
for lists of Electors  
in 1860 not to be  
made.**

II. The rolls in force on the thirty-first day of December in the  
year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine shall have the same  
force and be dealt with in the same manner as if they were the alpha-  
betical lists mentioned in the twelfth section of the said Act. **Rolls in force on 31st  
December 1859 to  
be dealt with as  
lists under 22 Vict.  
No. 81.**

III. So much of the said section of the said Act as relates to the  
printing of the lists made out under the provisions thereof and so much  
of the said section as relates to the advertisement transmission disposition  
and sale of the printed copies of such lists and so much of the twentieth  
section of the said Act as requires the registrars to cause the names on  
the rolls to be arranged in alphabetical order and to prefix to every name  
in such rolls a number and to cause copies of the said rolls to be printed  
shall not be in force during the year One thousand eight hundred and  
sixty. **Provision for print-  
ing &c. of lists  
not to apply to  
lists to be made  
out under this Act.**

Registrar to produce rolls.

IV. In lieu of the original papers sent in by the collectors which by the sixteenth section of the said Act the registrar is required to produce at the revision court the registrar shall produce at such court the rolls mentioned in the second section of this Act.

Registrars to make out catalogues of names inserted or expunged from electoral rolls.

V. After the clerk of the court of petty sessions revising the rolls mentioned in the second section of this Act shall have returned such rolls (when revised and made the roll) to the registrar from whom the same shall have been received such registrar shall make out a catalogue of all persons whose names shall by such court have been inserted in such rolls when under revision by such court and another catalogue of all persons whose names shall have been expunged by such court from such rolls together with the numbers prefixed to such last-mentioned names and shall cause the names in each such catalogue to be arranged in alphabetical order and shall cause a sufficient number of copies of such catalogues to be printed and shall transmit a printed copy of each of such catalogues signed by himself in the forms marked (A) and (B) in the schedule to this Act annexed to the returning officer of the province and district within which the division of which he shall be registrar shall be comprised and the same shall be furnished to persons applying for them in the same manner as by the said Act is required with respect to copies of the roll.

Governor in Council may direct registrar to arrange names in alphabetical series and prefix a number.

VI. Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to direct any registrar to arrange in one continuous alphabetical series all names which by such court shall have been retained and inserted in such rolls when under revision as aforesaid and to prefix to every such name a number and to cause a sufficient number of copies of the roll containing such names so arranged as aforesaid to be printed.

And to make out alphabetical lists of electors in new divisions.

VII. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to direct any registrar to make out from the general and special electoral rolls of persons entitled to vote in any existing division or divisions separate alphabetical lists of persons whose qualifications shall be comprised within the area of any divisions into which the Governor in Council may at any time hereafter divide such existing division or divisions and such registrar shall transmit to the clerk of each court of petty sessions which shall act as the revision court for one of such new divisions such rolls and such one of such lists as shall be the list for such division respectively and the justices assembled at such court shall in case it shall appear that such registrar has inserted the name of any person entitled to be placed on one of such lists in the list for a division within whose area the qualification of such person shall not be comprised cause the name of such person to be expunged from the list for such division and direct the registrar to insert the same in the roll for the division within whose area the qualification of such person shall be comprised but nothing in this section contained shall be deemed to prevent such justices from causing names to be inserted in or to be expunged from any of such lists in the same manner as they might have done if the registrar had not made out such separate lists as aforesaid.

Justices to send revised lists to registrars.

VIII. After the said justices shall have revised the said lists in the manner hereinbefore provided they shall transmit the same to the said registrar who shall deal with the same in the same manner as he is by the twentieth section of the said Act required to deal with the lists when received from the clerk of the court of petty sessions revising the same.

IX. The several courts of petty sessions mentioned in the second schedule

schedule to the said Act shall on the first Monday in the month of January in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-one and in each succeeding year proceed to select and appoint collectors in the same manner as is required by such section but any collector now or hereafter to be appointed shall be eligible to be re-appointed and in case any collector appointed under the said Act shall be guilty of wilful misconduct in the execution of the duties of his office or shall die or resign refuse or become incapable to act the court of petty sessions by whom he shall have been appointed shall as soon as possible appoint some other fit and proper person to be collector in his stead.

X. The word "this" occurring in the thirty-fifth section of the said Act before the word "year" shall be read as if the word "each" had been inserted instead thereof.

Interpretation of the word "this" in the 35 sec. 22 Vict. No. 81.

XI. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to order that the time for doing any act matter or thing by the said Act required to be done shall be postponed for such period as he shall think fit and whenever any such postponement shall be made the same periods of time as in the said Act provided between the various acts matters or things required by the said Act to be done shall be preserved.

Governor in Council may extend time in which anything under this Act is required to be done.
