

An Act to extend the operation of Part III. of the Employers and Employés Act 1890.

 $\lceil 6th \ November, 1893. \rceil$

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in section forty-five of the Operation of Part Employers and Employés Act 1890, Part III. of the said Act which relates to the liability of employers for injuries to employés shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December One thousand eight hundred and ninety-five and to the end of the then next session of Parliament and no longer unless Parliament otherwise determine.
