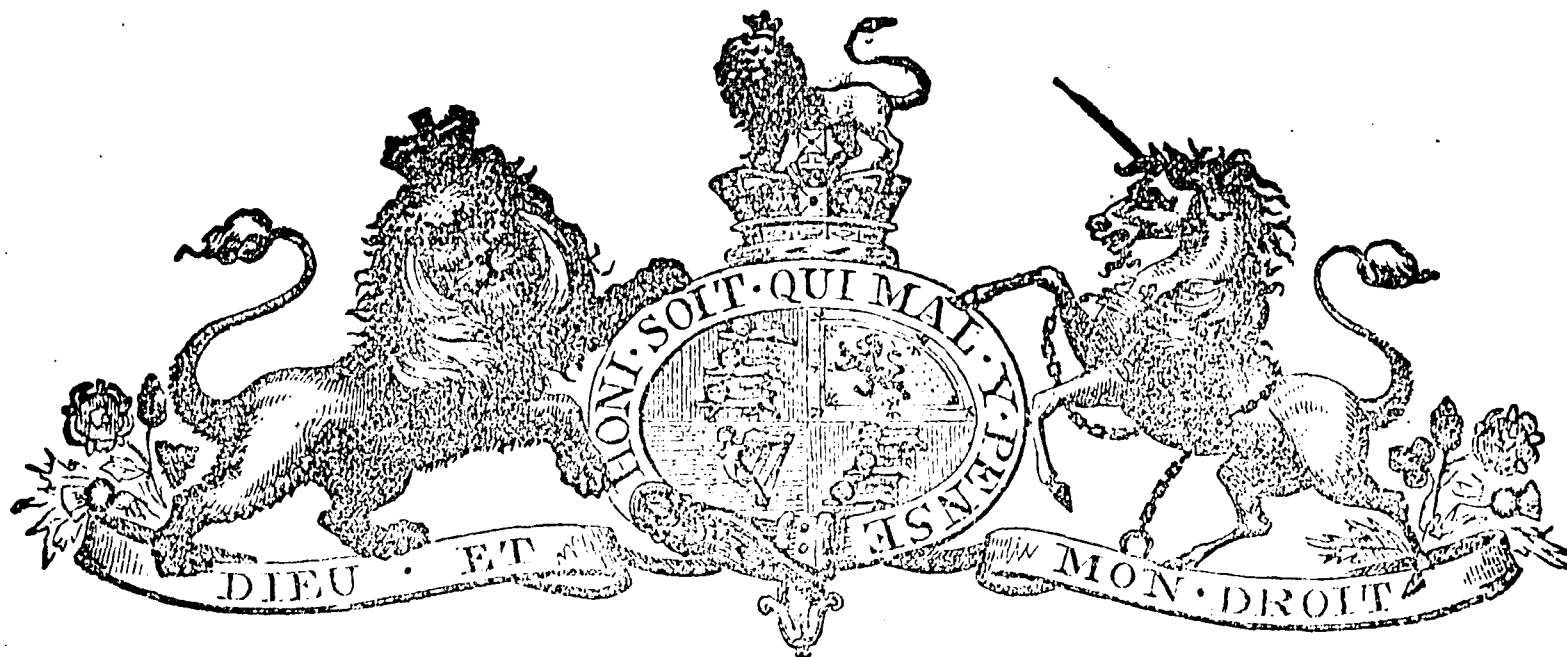

An Act to provide for a Grant to the Widow and
Family of the late James Macpherson Grant.

[18th *December* 1885.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN—

WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament assembled having taken into consideration the Message of His Excellency the Governor recommending that provision should be made for a grant to the widow and family of the late Honorable James Macpherson Grant Member of the Legislative Assembly do most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

Preamble.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be issued and applied the sum of Three thousand pounds which shall be paid to Mary Grant the widow of the late Honorable James Macpherson Grant Member of Parliament to be appropriated by her as follows :— One thousand pounds for the said widow and the balance of Two thousand pounds to be held by her in trust for each child in equal proportions.
