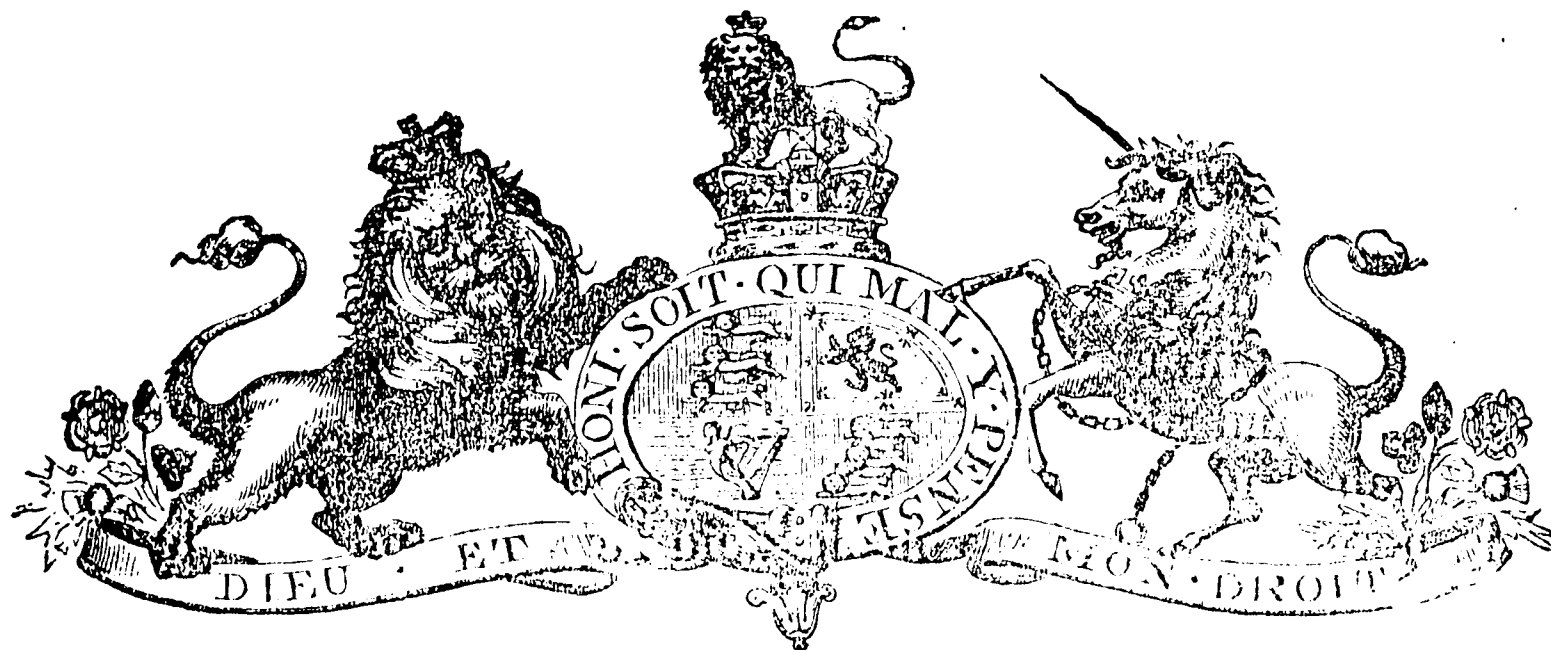

An Act to set apart a Site for a Morgue in the City of Melbourne.

[16th December 1886.]

**W**HEREAS by an Order made on the ninth day of June in the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy-three the Governor by and with the advice of the Executive Council did reserve from sale permanently, and whereas by a deed dated on the thirteenth day of the said month Her Majesty did grant unto the Board of Land and Works and to the mayor aldermen councillors and citizens of the city of Melbourne and to their successors, certain Crown land within the city of Melbourne in order to provide a public park known as Flinders Park: And whereas a portion of the land so granted being that described in the Schedule hereto is now required as a site for a Morgue, and it is expedient that such portion should be resumed by Her Majesty and that the same should be vested in the Board of Land and Works: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Preamble.

Schedule.

1. The Order in Council made on the ninth day of June One thousand eight hundred and seventy-three by which certain land in the county of Bourke, city of Melbourne, was reserved from sale permanently in order to provide a public park known as Flinders Park shall as to so much of such land as is described in the Schedule hereto be

be and the same is hereby revoked; and the grant by Her Majesty to the Board of Land and Works and to the mayor aldermen councillors and citizens of the city of Melbourne and to their successors of the land so reserved from sale permanently and the enrolment of the record of such grant and the release dated the sixteenth day of September in the said year of certain exemptions reservations and provisoes contained in the said grant and also the enrolment of the said release shall as to so much of such land as is described in the Schedule hereto be and the same are hereby respectively made void revoked and annulled.

2. The land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby vested in the Board of Land and Works as and for a site for a Morgue.

## SCHEDULE.

### SITE FOR MORGUE.

One rood twenty perches, city of Melbourne, county of Bourke: Commencing at a point bearing S. 28° E. five chains twenty links and N. 87° 25' E. twenty-four chains eighty links from the intersection of the south-eastern side of Flinders-street and the north-eastern side of Swanston-street; bounded thence by lines bearing respectively N. 22° 20' E. two chains fifty links, S. 67° 40' E. one chain fifty links, S. 22° 20' W. two chains fifty links, and north-westerly one chain fifty links in an arc of a circle whose centre lies twenty-three chains twenty-one links south-westerly to the point of commencement.
