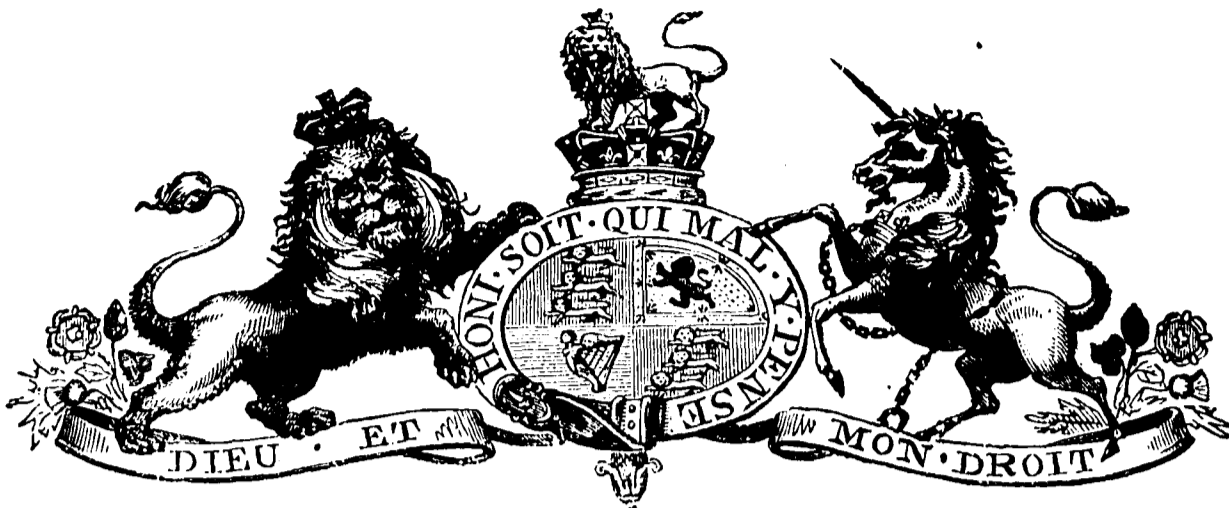

An Act relating to the Supplementary Lists and Rolls for the Legislative Assembly for the year One thousand nine hundred and nine.

[26th July, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Assembly Electoral Rolls Act* 1909, and shall be read and construed as one with Part IV. of *The Constitution Act Amendment Act* 1890, and such Act and any Act amending the same and this Act may be cited together as the *Constitution Act Amendment Acts*.

Short title and construction.

2. For the purpose only of the preparation printing publishing and revision of the supplementary lists and rolls for the Legislative Assembly during the year One thousand nine hundred and nine the undermentioned alterations of dates shall as from the second day of April

Alteration of times for preparing supplementary electoral rolls for Legislative Assembly for 1909.

April in the said year be deemed to have been made in the provisions of *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1890* as amended by *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1898* and the *Purification of Rolls Act 1891* respectively:—

- (a) In section one hundred and sixty of *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1890* for the word “May” there shall be substituted the word “June”;
- (b) In section one hundred and sixty-two of the said Act for the word “July” there shall be substituted the word “August”;
- (c) In section one hundred and sixty-four of the said Act for the words “fifteenth day of July” there shall be substituted the words “sixteenth day of August”;
- (d) In section one hundred and seventy-five of the said Act as re-enacted for the word “August” wherever occurring there shall be substituted the word “September”;
- (e) In section one hundred and eighty-five of the said Act for the word “September” there shall be substituted the word “October”;
- No. 1242. (f) In section eighteen of the *Purification of Rolls Act 1891* for the word “July” there shall be substituted the word “August”; and
- No. 1601. (g) In section fourteen of *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1898* for the word “April” there shall be substituted the word “May.”

And references in any of the Schedules to any of the Acts hereinbefore mentioned or in any rights or forms issued thereunder shall where necessary be altered to accord with the amendments made by this Act.
