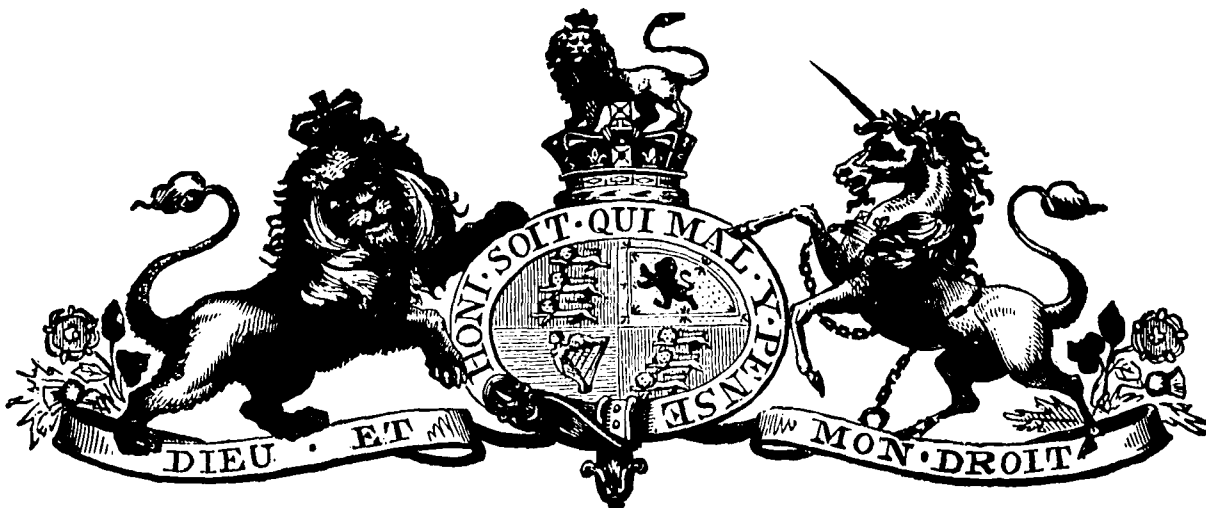

An Act to provide for the further Appointment of an Acting Victorian Railways Commissioner.

[19th August, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Acting Victorian Railways Commissioner Act 1902*, and shall be read and construed as one with the Railways Acts, and shall be deemed and taken to have come into force on the second day of August One thousand nine hundred and two.

Short title and construction.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Railways Acts the Governor in Council may for six months from the second day of August One thousand nine hundred and two fill up the office of "The Victorian Railways Commissioner" by the further appointment thereto of an Acting Commissioner; and in making any appointment pursuant to this section the period for which any Acting Commissioner is appointed shall be specified by the Governor in Council; and sub-section (3) of section forty-two of the *Railways Act 1891* shall subject to the Railways Acts be deemed to apply to any such Acting Commissioner.

Power to further appoint an Acting Commissioner for six months.
