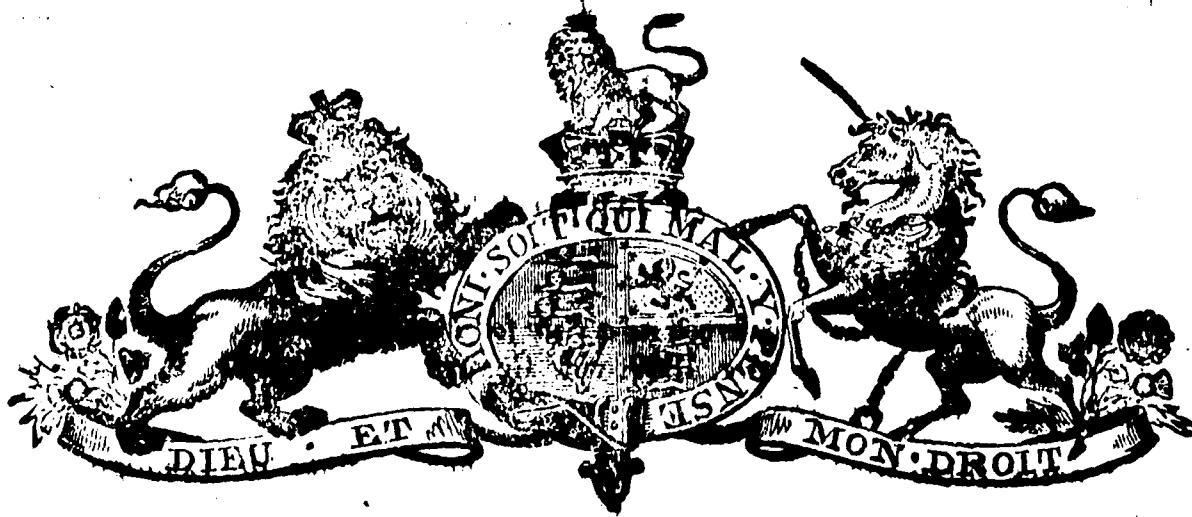

An Act to revoke the Permanent Reservation of certain Land in the City of Bendigo.

[23rd December, 1912.]

WHEREAS by Order in Council of the seventeenth day of November One thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine the land described in the Schedule to this Act was reserved from sale permanently as a site for public recreation purposes : And whereas the said land is not now required for the said purposes but is suitable for the purposes of a High School : Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bendigo Land Act* 1912.

Short title.

2. The permanent reservation of the said land is hereby revoked and the said land shall be deemed to be and may be dealt with as unoccupied Crown lands.

Land ordered to be permanently reserved as a Site for Public Recreation purposes by Order in Council of the 17th November, 1869, vide Government Gazette of the 26th November, 1869, pages 1882 and 1883.

Four acres three roods and thirty-nine perches, county of Bendigo, borough of Sandhurst, now city of Bendigo: Commencing at a point bearing S. 41° 35' W. fifty-two links from west angle of the gaol reserve; bounded thence by lines bearing respectively S. 50° 49' E. eight chains seventy-two links, S. 53° 57' E. fifty-five links, S. 50° 49' E. one chain five links, S. 41° 59' W. three chains seventy-one links, S. 58° 56' W. one chain sixty-four links, S. 54° 35' W. fifty-seven links, N. 48° 25' W. nine chains twenty-six links, and N. 41° 35' E. four chains eighty-six links to the point of commencement.
