

An Act to amend Section Four of the *Carriages Act 1928*.

[9th December, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Carriages Act 1940* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Carriages Act 1928* (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act amending the same all of which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Carriages Acts.

“ Any reference in this or the next succeeding section to a power or authority to make by-laws for licensing regulating and limiting the number of hackney carriages and the owners and drivers of such hackney carriages or to make regulations touching the licensing and conduct of the owners drivers and conductors of such hackney carriages shall without affecting the generality thereof be deemed to include a reference to a power or authority to make by-laws or regulations for or with respect to the cancellation revocation or suspension of such licences.”
