Corrections (Remission) Act 1988

[Assented to 8 March 1988]

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to make provision with respect to the effect of the Corrections Regulations 1988 concerning remission on sentences of imprisonment.

Commencement.

2. This Act is deemed to have come into operation on 1 March 1988.

Effect of Corrections Regulations 1988.

3. (1) The Corrections Regulations 1988 are deemed to have been made as amended by Regulation 5 of the Corrections (Amendment) Regulations 1988.
