Constitution (Ministers) Act 1992

[Assented to 9 November 1992]

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. *Purpose*

The purpose of this Act is to increase the number of Ministers of the Crown.

2. *Commencement*

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. *Amendment of section 50*

In section 50 of the **Constitution Act 1975**—

- (a) in sub-section (1), for “eighteen” substitute “22”;
- (b) in sub-section (3) for “thirteen” substitute “17”.
