An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act 1967 and for other purposes.

[16th May, 1975.]

RE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):-

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Cattle Compensation Short title. (Amendment) Act 1975.
- (2) In this Act the Cattle Compensation Act 1967 is called the Principal Act No. 7615 as Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Commenceproclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

- 2. The Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (a) In the interpretation of "Chief inspector of stock" and "Inspector of stock" in section 3, in paragraph (c) of sub-section (1) of section 4, in paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section 4, in sub-section (2) of section 7, in paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) in

section

- section 7, in paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 21, for the expression "Stock Diseases Act 1958" (wherever occurring) there shall be substituted the expression "Stock Diseases Act 1968";
- (b) In the interpretation of "Disease" in section 3 after the words "Johne's disease" there shall be inserted the words "or brucellosis":
- (c) In paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section 4 after the words "Johne's disease" there shall be inserted the word "brucellosis":
- (d) In paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) of section 10 the word "and" shall be repealed:
- (e) After paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) of section 10 there shall be inserted the following paragraph:—
  - "(ba) any moneys paid by the Commonwealth of Australia for or in respect of the payment of compensation for cattle which were suffering from brucellosis; and"
