

An Act to revoke the permanent reservation of certain Crown Land in the County of Polwarth, Town of Colac.

[6th April, 1903.]

THEREAS by an Order in Council dated the tenth day of August Preamble. One thousand eight hundred and seventy-four the land Government Gazette: described in the First Schedule to this Act was reserved from sale permanently as a site for a market: And whereas of the land so reserved the part described in the Second Schedule to this Act is not required for the purpose for which the same was reserved and it is expedient for His Majesty to resume possession of such part: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the Colac Market Land Act 1903.

Short title. .

2. The said recited Order in Council by which the land in the Revocation of county of Polwarth town of Colac described in the First Schedule to permanent this Act was reserved from sale permanently as a site for a market certain land. shall be and the same is hereby revoked so far only as such Order in First Schedule. Council relates to the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act Second Schedule. and the land described in such Second Schedule may be dealt with as unoccupied Crown land.

Section 2.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Land permanently reserved by Order in Council of the 10th August, 1874, as a site for market, vide Gazettes of the 20th February, 1874, page 359, and the 21st August, 1874, page 1566.

Five acres, county of Polwarth, town of Colac, being section 10: Commencing at the intersection of the southern side of Dennis-street and the western side of Hesse-street; bounded thence by the latter street bearing S. 10° 0′ E. five chains; thence by Murray-street bearing S. 80° 0′ W. ten chains; thence by Gellibrand-street bearing N. 10° 0′ W. five chains; and thence by Dennis-street aforesaid bearing N. 80° 0′ E. ten chains to the point of commencement.

Section 2.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Portion of the reservation is revoked by this Act.

One rood twenty perches and six-tenths, county of Polwarth, town of Colac, being part of section 10: Commencing at the intersection of the western side of Hesse-street and the northern side of Murray-street; bounded thence by the latter street bearing S. 80° 0′ W. one chain fifty-one links and a half; thence by lines bearing respectively N. 10° 0′ W. two chains fifty links and N. 80° 0′ E. one chain fifty-one links and a half; and thence by Hesse-street aforesaid bearing S. 10° 0′ E. two chains fifty links to the point of commencement.
