

An Act to amend Section Four of the *Closer Settlement Act 1937*.

[19th September, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title construction and citation.

Nos. 3656, 3843, 3938, 4008, 4091, 4150, 4196 Part I., 4257, 4328, 4521.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Closer Settlement (Temporary Provisions) Act 1938* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Closer Settlement Act 1928* and any Act amending the same all of which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the *Closer Settlement Acts*.

2. In sub-section (1) of section four of the *Closer Settlement Act 1937*—

Extension of operation of provisions for half-yearly payments by settlers.

- (a) after the words “and thirty-seven” (where occurring for the second time) there shall be inserted the words “and the financial year beginning on the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight”;
- (b) for the words “that financial year” there shall be substituted the words “each of those financial years”; and
- (c) for the words “said first day of July” (wherever occurring) there shall be substituted the words “first day of July One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven”.
