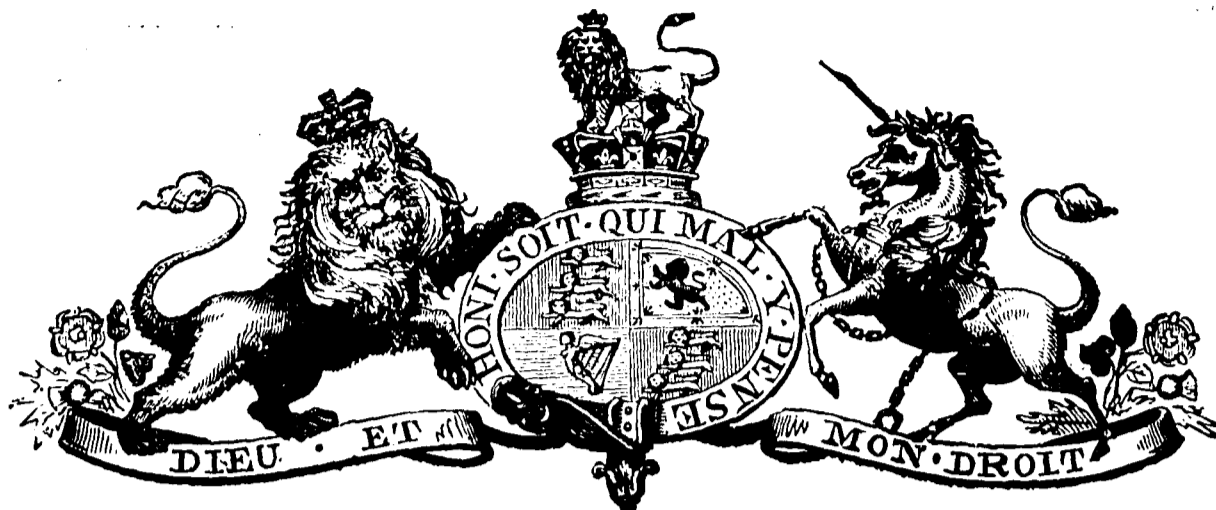

An Act relating to the preparation of Electoral Rolls for the Legislative Council and for the Legislative Assembly.

[22nd December, 1903.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Electoral Rolls Act 1903*.

Short title.

2. The operation of the sections specified in the Schedule to this Act shall be and the same is hereby suspended, and until resumed as hereinafter provided such sections shall have no force or effect.

Suspension of enactments re Electoral Lists and Rolls.

3. (1) The Governor in Council may by Order published in the *Government Gazette* direct that the operation of the said sections shall be resumed, but with such alterations and extensions of the dates and times named therein as may be specified in such Order with regard only to all General Lists and Lists of Ratepaying Electors prepared or in course of preparation at the passing of this Act; and the said sections the operation of which is so ordered to be resumed shall, subject to such Order, thenceforth have full force and effect accordingly.

Resumption of operation of enactments.

(2) There shall be made in the said electoral lists so prepared or in course of preparation and in the rolls prepared therefrom such additions and alterations as are necessary to provide for the inclusion in such electoral lists and rolls of the names of all persons qualified to be voters for the Legislative Council pursuant to the provisions of *The Constitution Act 1903*.
