An Act to make provision for Increasing the Salaries
of the Commissioners of the Forests Commission.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

Commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Forests (Commissioners) Act* 1947 and shall be read and construed as one with the *Forests Act* 1928 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act and enactment amending the same all of which Acts and enactments and this Act may be cited together as the Forests Acts.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January One thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

2. (1) In sub-section (1) of section eleven of the Principal Act—

(a) for the words "One thousand pounds" there shall be substituted the words "One thousand five hundred pounds";

(b) for the words "Eight hundred pounds" there shall be substituted the words "One thousand one hundred pounds".

(2) Notwithstanding anything in sub-section (3) of section eleven of the Principal Act the Governor in Council may during the current term of any commissioner in office at the commencement of this Act determine the rate of salary of that commissioner subject to the limits provided in sub-section (1) of the said section eleven as amended by sub-section (1) of this section.
