

An Act to provide for the Closing of portions of certain Streets in the City of Footscray and for the Reservation from Sale of the said portions as a Site for Educational purposes.

[30th December, 1924.]

WHEREAS the land described in the First Schedule to this Act was by Order in Council dated the thirteenth day of July One thousand eight hundred and seventy-five temporarily reserved from sale as a site for State school purposes : And whereas the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act was by Order in Council dated the thirteenth day of May One thousand nine hundred and eight temporarily reserved as a site for State school purposes : And whereas the land described in the Third Schedule to this Act forms portion of a street in the city of Footscray set out on Crown land and known as Parker-street : And whereas the land described in the Fourth Schedule to this Act forms portion of a street in the said city

city set out on Crown land and known as Railway-parade : And whereas the lands described in the said Third and Fourth Schedules are adjacent to the lands described in the said First and Second Schedules : And whereas it is expedient to provide that the lands described in the said Third and Fourth Schedules shall cease to form part of the said streets in order that the said lands may become and be dealt with as unalienated lands of the Crown and may pursuant to the Land Acts be reserved from sale as a site for educational purposes : And whereas the council of the city of Footscray has consented to the closing of the said portions of the said streets : Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Footscray Land Act* 1924.

2. (1) The hereinbefore recited street known as Parker-street to the extent mentioned in the Third Schedule to this Act is hereby declared to be and the same shall be closed.

Fourth

(2) The hereinbefore recited street known as Railway-parade to the extent mentioned in the Fourth Schedule to this Act is hereby declared to be and the same shall be closed.

(3) All rights easements and privileges existing or claimed as regards the said portions of the said streets either in the public or by any body or person whatsoever or whomsoever as incident to any past dedication or supposed dedication thereof or of any past user thereof or by any fiction of law shall cease and determine.

3. The lands described in the Third and Fourth Schedules to this Act shall be deemed to be and may be dealt with as unalienated lands of the Crown, and may be reserved from sale pursuant to the Land Acts as a site for educational purposes.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Land temporarily reserved from sale by Order-in-Council of the 13th July, 1875, as a Site for State School purposes (vide "Government Gazette" of the 16th July, 1875, page 1374). Preamble

One acre, one rood, nineteen perches, county of Bourke, borough (now City) of Footscray, being part of section 9A (now allotment 3, section 9A): Commencing at the southern angle of the site, being the intersection of the north-eastern side of Parker-street with the north-western side of Hyde-street; bounded thence by Parker-street bearing N. $79^{\circ} 5' W.$ five chains forty-eight links; thence by a street (now Railway-parade) bearing N. $27^{\circ} 24' E.$ two chains eighty-three links; thence by the Wesleyan Church reserve bearing S. $79^{\circ} 5' E.$ four chains sixty-eight links; and thence by Hyde-street bearing S. $10^{\circ} 55' W.$ two chains seventy links to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Land temporarily reserved from sale by Order of the 13th May, 1908, as a Site for State School purposes, in addition to the site temporarily reserved therefor by Order of the 13th July, 1875 (vide "Government Gazette" of the 20th May, 1908, page 2707). Preamble.

Two roods twenty-two perches, county of Bourke, city of Footscray, being part of section 9B: Commencing at the intersection of the southern side of Parker-street and the western side of Hyde-street; bounded thence by the latter street bearing S. $11^{\circ} 18' W.$ two chains fifty-two links and one-half of a link; thence by Smith-street bearing N. $78^{\circ} 42' W.$ two chains fifty links; thence by allotment 3 bearing N. $11^{\circ} 18' E.$ two chains fifty-five links; and thence by Parker-street bearing S. $78^{\circ} 21' E.$ two chains fifty links to the point of commencement.

THIRD SCHEDULE.

Portion of Parker-street in the City of Footscray to be closed.

City of Footscray, parish of Cut-paw-paw, county of Bourke, being that portion of Parker-street hereinafter described viz.: Commencing at the south-east angle of the site for a State school, being allotment 3 of section 9A; bounded thence by Hyde-street bearing S. $10^{\circ} 55' W.$ one chain fifty links; by the south side of Parker-street, bearing N. $78^{\circ} 21' W.$ five chains ninety-eight links; by Railway-parade bearing N. $30^{\circ} 5' E.$ one chain fifty-eight links; and thence by allotment 3 of section 9A bearing S. $79^{\circ} 5' E.$ five chains forty-eight links to the point of commencement.

FOURTH SCHEDULE.

Portion of Railway-parade in the City of Footscray to be closed.

City of Footscray, parish of Cut-paw-paw, county of Bourke, being that portion of Railway-parade hereinafter described, viz.: Commencing at the north-west angle of the State school site being allotment 3 of section 9A; bounded thence by the said school site bearing S. $27^{\circ} 24' W.$ two chains eighty-three links; by Parker-street bearing S. $30^{\circ} 5' W.$ one chain fifty-eight links; by allotments 1 and 4 of section 9B bearing S. $28^{\circ} 3' W.$ two chains seventy links; by a line bearing N. $22^{\circ} 37' W.$ one chain thirty links; by the west boundary of Railway Parade, bearing N. $28^{\circ} 23' E.$ five chains ninety-eight links; and thence by a line bearing S. $79^{\circ} 5' E.$ one chain four links to the point of commencement.
