An Act to amend Sections 5, 11, and 26 of the *Friendly Societies Act* 1958.

[10th December, 1974.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :--

## Short title.

Principal Act No. 6255 as amended by Nos. 7705, 7876, 7911, 8181. Commence-

Commencement.

Amendment of No. 6255 s. 26. Increase in amount of benefits.

Amendment of No. 6255 ss. 5 and 11. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Friendly Societies (Benefits) Act 1974.

(2) The Friendly Societies Act 1958 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

2. In section 26 of the Principal Act for the expression "\$30 a week" there shall be substituted the expression "\$50 a week".

3. In the proviso to section 5 of the Principal Act and in sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (11) in section 11 of the Principal Act for the expression "\$30 a week" (where respectively occurring) there shall be substituted the expression "\$50 a week".
