An Act to further amend Section Eleven of the
Game Act 1928.

[21st May, 1957.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Game (Destruction) Act 1957* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Game Act 1928* (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and the Acts amending the same all of which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Game Acts.

2. In sub-section (3) of section eleven of the Principal Act as amended by any Act for the words "One thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven" there shall be substituted the words "One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight".
