

An Act to amend the Health Acts with regard to Vaccination Certificates.

[23rd December, 1912.]

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with D the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the Health Act 1912 and shall be Short title and read and construed as one with the Health Act 1890 which Act and construction. any Acts amending the same and this Act may be cited together as the Nos. 1098, 1362, 1718, 1866, 2126. Health Acts.

Amendment of No. 1098 s. 202. Transmission of vaccination certificates. 3. In section two hundred and two of the *Health Act* 1890 for the words "performance of the operation of," there shall be substituted the word "successful."

Medical practitioner to transmit duplicate certificate to Registrar.

4. Where the vaccination of a child is performed by a medical practitioner not being a public vaccinator the duty of immediately transmitting to the registrar a duplicate certificate of the successful vaccination of such child instead of being performed by the parent is hereby imposed upon such practitioner; and for any contravention of this section such medical practitioner shall be liable to a penalty of not less than Ten or more than Forty shillings.

Amendment of Seventeenth Schedule No. 1098.

- 5. (1) In the Seventeenth Schedule to the said Act—
 - (a) for the words "within twenty-one days from" there shall be substituted the words "immediately after."
 - (b) for the words "is within twenty-one days to" there shall be substituted the words "shall immediately."

Amendment of Schedules.

(2) Regulations may be made under and pursuant to section one hundred and ninety-two of the Health Act 1890 making such amendments of the Schedules to the said Act as may be necessary for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this Act.
