An Act to amend the *Health Act 1958*.

[21st December, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Health (Amendment) Act 1960*.

Principal Act.
No. 6270.

(2) The *Health Act 1958* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Commencement.

(3) This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

2. For paragraph (d) of sub-section (2) of section sixty-five of the Principal Act there shall be substituted the following paragraph—

Fees for
examination of
plans &c. of
septic tank
systems.

“(d) pay to the council such fee not exceeding Four pounds as the council may by by-law fix for the examination of such plans specifications particulars and description and any inspection of the site and installations.”

3. In sub-section (2) of section three hundred and ninety-four of the Principal Act after the words "All by-laws" there shall be inserted the words "except a by-law made for the purposes of paragraph (d) of sub-section (2) of section sixty-five of this Act".

Amendment of No. 6270 s. 394. Exemption from certain requirements as to publication.

4. In section two hundred and thirty of the Principal Act after the word "food" (wherever occurring) there shall be inserted the words "or drug".

Amendment of No. 6270 s. 250. Prohibition of the mixing of drugs with injurious ingredients and of selling the same.

5. For sub-section (4) of section three hundred and fifteen of the Principal Act there shall be substituted the following sub-section :—

"(4) Every meat inspector shall furnish to the Commission in writing—

Meat inspector to furnish returns.

(a) within one week after the expiration of each calendar month a report in respect of that month ; and

(b) forthwith upon receiving any request in writing from the Secretary to that effect, a special report in respect of the matters referred to in that request—

and every such report shall contain such information and particulars as the Commission requires as to the matters entered in such book."
