An Act to amend the *Constitution Act* 1975 and the *County Court Act* 1958 with respect to Salaries of Judges.

[29th November, 1977]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Judges Salaries Act 1977.

Commencement.

- (2) The several provisions of this Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

- 2. Section 82 of the Constitution Act 1975 shall be amended as follows:—
 - (a) In sub-section (1) for the expression "\$48,370" there shall be substituted the expression "\$51,900"; and
 - (b) In sub-section (2) for the expression "\$43,920" there shall be substituted the expression "\$47,190".

- 3. Sub-section (1) of section 10 of the County Court Act 1958 is Amendment of No. 6230. hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) In paragraph (a) for the expression "\$43,350" there subsequently shall be substituted the expression "\$46,580"; and amended by Nos. 8680. 8853, (b) In paragraph (b) for the expression "\$36,960" there shall be substituted the expression "\$39,820".
