An Act relating to the Salaries and Allowances of  
Judges of the Supreme and County Courts.

[6th June, 1956.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Judges Salaries and Allowances Act 1956*.

Commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the sixth day of May One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

Supreme Court  
Judges.

2. For paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section twelve of the *Supreme Court Act 1928* as amended by any Act there shall be substituted the following paragraph :—

“(a) The Judges of the Court shall be entitled to the following annual salaries and annual allowances :—

(i) The Chief Justice to a salary at the rate of Five thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds and an allowance at the rate of Five hundred pounds ;

(ii) Each

- (ii) Each puisne Judge to a salary at the rate of Five thousand one hundred and fifty pounds and an allowance at the rate of Three hundred and fifty pounds—

and such salaries and allowances shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.”

**3.** For paragraph (a) of sub-section (3) of section nine of the *County Court Act 1928* as amended by any Act there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“(a) Each judge shall be entitled to receive an annual salary at the rate of Three thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds and an annual allowance at the rate of One hundred and fifty pounds.”
