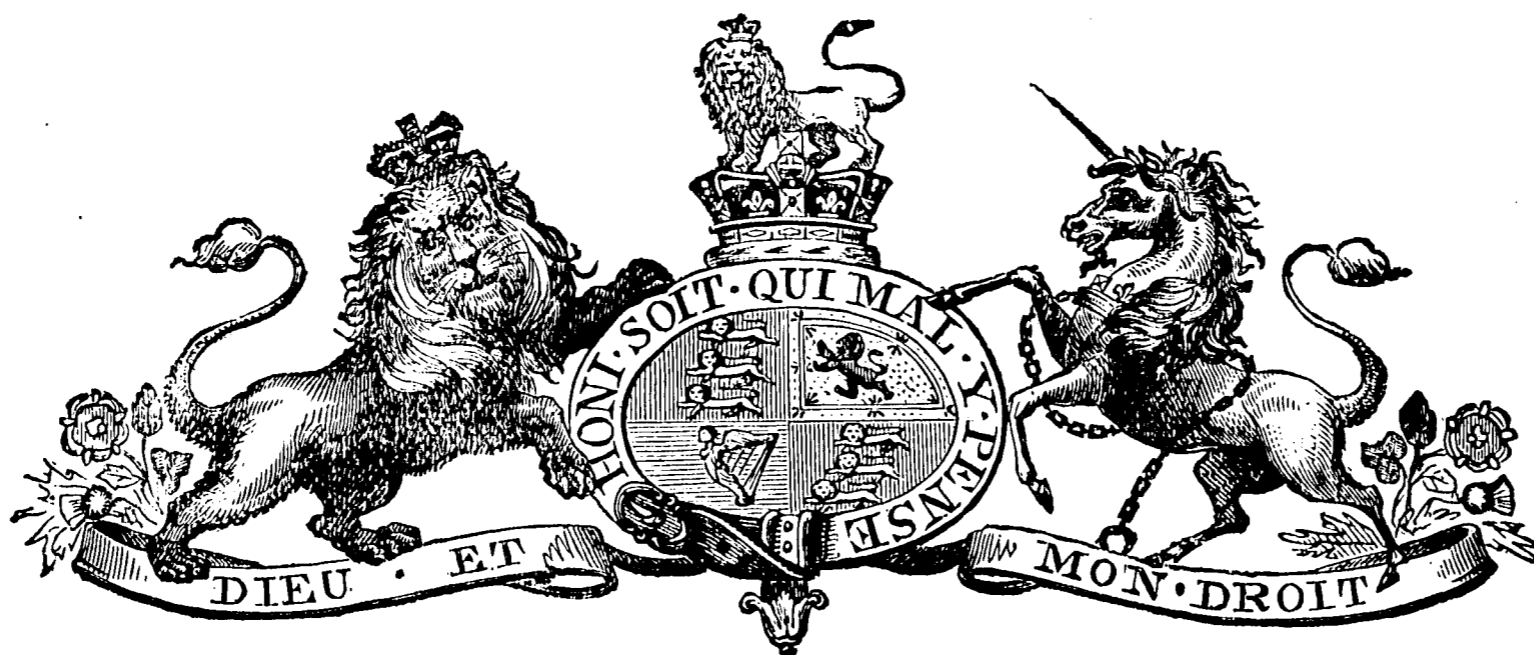

An Act relating to Swamp Lands.

[3rd November, 1893.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Land Act* 1893, and shall be construed as one with the Land Acts.

Short title and construction.

2. Section eighty of the *Land Act* 1890 is hereby repealed.

Repeal of section 80 of No. 1106.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in section six of the *Land Act* 1890 the Governor in Council may increase the area of land described in the Second Schedule to the said Act as lands which may be sold by auction by adding thereto any portion of the Crown lands described in the said Schedule as Swamp lands.

Power to order sale of swamp lands.
