

An Act to further amend the Libraries Act 1890.

[24th December, 1903.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :-

1. This Act may be cited as the Libraries Act 1903, and shall be Short title and construction. construed as one with Part I. of the Libraries Act 1890.

2. Whenever any trustee shall have after the commencement of Absence of trustee this Act been absent for four consecutive months from all general meetings of the trustees without leave obtained from the trustees in vacates office. that behalf then the office of such trustee shall thereupon become vacant.

for four months without leave

3. No new trustee shall be appointed so as to increase the number Number of trustees to be limited. of trustees to more than eighteen.
