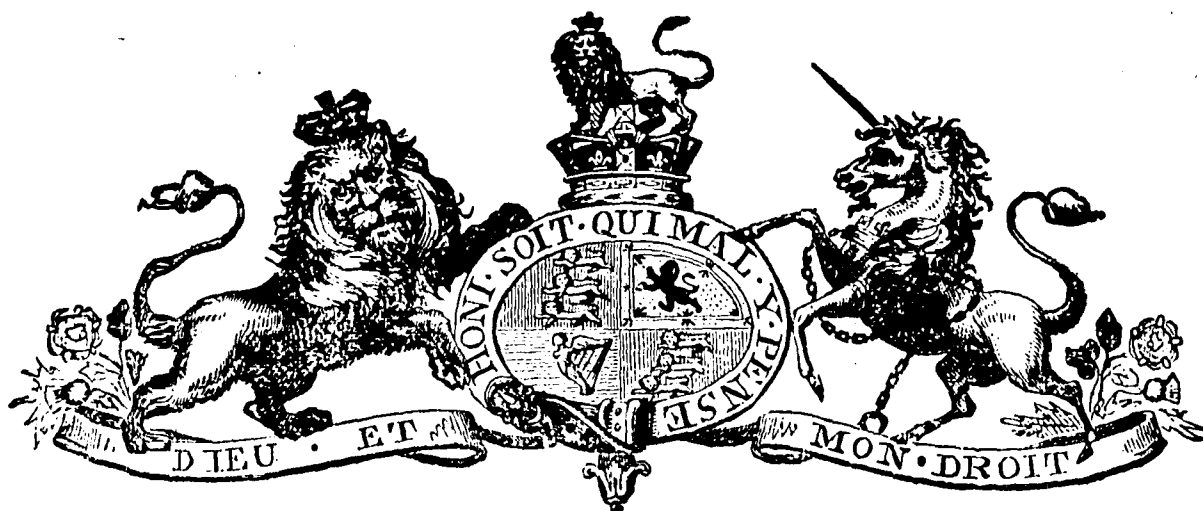

An Act to further amend the *Libraries Act* 1890.

[24th December, 1903.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Libraries Act* 1903, and shall be construed as one with Part I. of the *Libraries Act* 1890.

Short title and construction.

2. Whenever any trustee shall have after the commencement of this Act been absent for four consecutive months from all general meetings of the trustees without leave obtained from the trustees in that behalf then the office of such trustee shall thereupon become vacant.

Absence of trustee for four months without leave vacates office.

3. No new trustee shall be appointed so as to increase the number of trustees to more than eighteen.

Number of trustees to be limited.
